

## **Budweiser Holiday Truck**

### **Forum Hoard #147 – Christmas Wars**

**The Budweiser Holiday Truck consists of twenty (20) parts. The cab consists of six parts, with six optional tire tread pieces. The trailer consists of four parts, with four optional tire treads.**

**I started by scoring, cutting and edging the cab parts. The most difficult part is the front end. Start with the fender/hood pieces. Once attached to the front bumper, roll the fender top over the fenders and glue. Let it dry well before going on to attaching to the cab. Start attaching the front end to the cab by lining up the grill/hood edge to the front of the hood sides on the cab. Once aligned glue from the back of the hood moving forward. Then glue the back ends of the front end to the inside of the cab (aft of the wheel well).**



**After gluing in the windshield, start gluing the back end, starting at the back. Working a little bit of a roll into the cab roof and the sleeper roof helps**



**Gluing on the quick hitch turntable finishes up the cab, unless you add the optional treads.**



**You probably don't need to see the 3d tire option, but here goes. Unfortunately, the only photos of this were taken on a different version of the chassis.**



**The trailer is fairly easy. On the template, there are two options for the pin. I like to keep things as much paper as possible, so I did the paper version**



**Depending on how tightly you wrapped the little pin on the trailer, you may have to enlarge the hole in the hitch plate. And that's it.**
