

## Brass Dragon Golem Instructions

First, print out your dragon golem! Then follow these steps in order to assemble it.

1. Score along all of the light blue lines with a sharp knife and a straight-edge.



2. Cut out the boxes surrounding the body, 4 legs, and 2 leg connectors. Scissors are fine at this stage, but if you want a perfect cut use your knife and straight-edge again.



3. Fold all of the pieces along the lines you scored in step 2.



4. Glue all of the pieces after folding EXCEPT FOR the leg connectors. I like to use a glue pen like the one pictured (Uhu Glue brand is even better), but you can use white glue in a pinch. Just remember, it's like my 6<sup>th</sup> grade teacher always used to say, "It takes VERY LITTLE glue to glue paper to paper!"



5. After the legs and body dry, cut them out around the outline. You can get as close as you want to the model in this step, depending on how much effort you want to put into it. As is generally the case, scissors offer speed, knife offers precision. I recommend having both on hand just in case. Also, use your knife to cut through the short red lines on the side of the body. The leg connectors will need to fit through here.



6. Carefully use a black fine point marker along the outside edge of all of your pieces, as well as anywhere there is white showing through. Make sure to color the reverse side of the leg connector tabs black as well, so no white will show on the finished product.



7. Attach the now black side of the connector tabs to the **UNDERSIDE** of the corresponding legs. The black should be facing up, and the reverse side should line up the the art on the underside of the legs.



8. Stick the legs through the body of the golem, again making sure that the black side of the connector tabs is facing up.



9. Glue the remaining legs onto the connector tabs. This view is from the bottom to show how they should line up.



10. Bend the legs pieces down at the center of the connector tabs. This should lift the golem off the ground and allow it to stand.



11. Finally, gently bend the legs down at the ankle/foot area. This will make the model stand more evenly and give it more perceived volume.
