

PREP & PRINT FILE

1. OPEN with ADOBE READER

2. OPEN THE LAYERS PANEL



(Menu) View
> Show/Hide
> Navigation Panes
> Layers

3. ADJUST LAYERS



Use the EYE icons to turn layers ON & OFF as required, as below.

4. PRINT

- Scale 100%
- Full Colour
- Landscape
- Best with Glossy Photo Paper/Card

TOOLS

- Scalpel/Craft Knife
- Small cutting mat
- Metal ruler
- Glue stick
- Glossy photo paper/card
- Scissors
- Adhesive tape
- Black Marker
- 20mm Washers or coins

WARNING !

CUT

— CUT STRAIGHT LINES

- Cut out each block of minis from the page.
- Cut each individual miniature 'strip' from the block.

FOLD

- - - FOLD DASHED LINES

- Following the instructions below to fold your miniatures.
- Fold BEFORE applying glue.

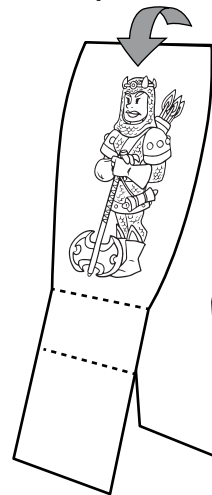

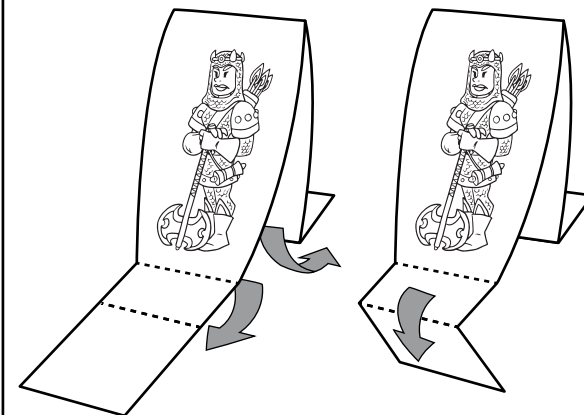
1. Cut carefully around the outer edges of the base, and more broadly around the figure art.



2. Fold strip in half, with print outwards.

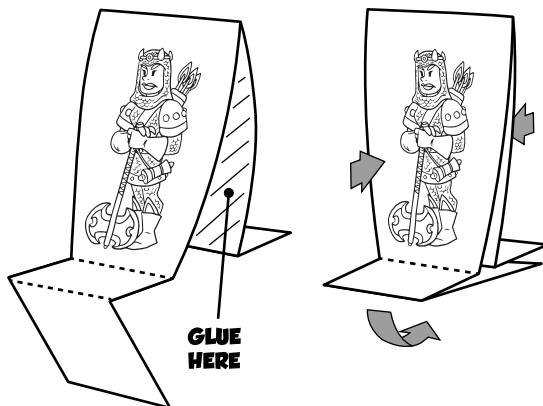


3. Fold 'base' tabs, at the first fold line, outwards. Fold the long 'base' tab at the second fold line, inwards.

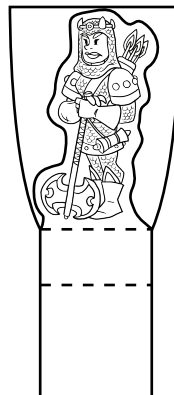


4. Glue the back of one figure face (not the base tabs)

Press artwork faces together. Make sure base tabs line up, but DON'T glue them yet!

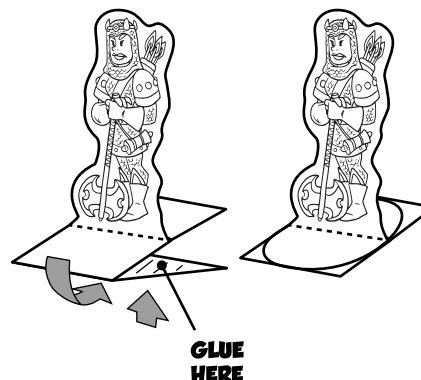


5. Trim figure to artwork.



6. Glue Base. Press Base tabs together.

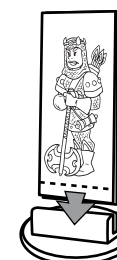
Trim ROUND base, (if you are using ROUND bases)



OTHER OPTIONS !

LEVEL UP!

- Trim with enough of the base on, to fit stand slot
- Insert folded card into plastic stand



DUNGEON MASTER!

- Trim with enough of the base on, to fit stand slot
- Glue faces together and trim artwork contour
- Laminate and trim again
- Insert figure into stand



PRO TIPS !

- If printing with BLACK backgrounds, use a permanent marker to clean up the edges.
- Let glue dry before cutting out artwork.
- Glue a coin or washer to the base for stability.
- Make it easier to fold by lightly 'scoring' (not cutting) the fold lines with a craft knife.
- OR, flattening folds with a hard, smooth object.
- Number the top of your bases for initiative.
- Glue the base and coat in sand or 'flock'.
